

FILLING THE GAP: ADVANCED PRESSURE WELDER TRAINING PROGRAM IMPACT REPORT 2021-2025

A five-year project developed and delivered in partnership between the CWB Group, the CWB Foundation and the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers (IBB), with funding from the Government of Canada through Employment and Social Development Canada's Union Training and Innovation Program (UTIP).



Advanced Pressure Welder Training is an intensive eightweek program designed to advance participants' skills in pressure welding. Through a blend of online learning and hands-on instruction at IBB facilities and partnering training institutions, participants gain practical experience

and technical knowledge. With a personalized learning approach, extensive hands-on practice, and guidance from industry experts, both apprentices and journeypersons are empowered to advance their welding careers to the next level.



TICKETS TO SUCCESS



All participants achieved at least one of the following welding tickets/qualifications:

- ► CWB four position
- Initial pressure welding test
- Carbon 2" sch. 160-6G Stick or TIG
- ► Stainless TIG root, Stick (fill and cap) 2" sch. 160-6G
- Inconel 2" sch. 160 TIG root, Stick fill and cap 6G
- 9 Chrome- 2" or 4" TIG all out 6G

100% of participants completed industry-required safety certifications.

With targeted training and by achieving specific pressure welding qualifications, participants can expand their skills and employment opportunities.


